What does a VIV do?

VIVs help the Librarians with our Summer Reading Club, this includes

- Signing kids up for the Summer Reading Club
- Giving out prizes when kids check-in throughout the summer
- Keeping reading records organized
- Organizing Summer Reading books
- Other simple tasks the librarians may need help with

Who can be a VIV?

Any student who will be entering grades 6-12 in September and is eager to volunteer.

How do I become a VIV?

You must come in to the Library with a parent/guardian to register to be a VIV. VIV registration will be held on Thursday, March 4 from 5:00-8:30pm. At the time of registration you will choose the dates/times you would like to volunteer in the summer. Please come prepared with your summer availability. If you would like to volunteer with a friend please come to the registration together.

Will I earn community service credit for being a VIV?

Yes! Every hour that you volunteer is an hour of community service. At the end of the summer you will receive an official letter stating how much time you volunteered with us.
